# DCIS Graduation Requirements

(1 semester = 5 credits)

Total Credits Required for Graduation = 240

*To be on track for Graduation you must earn a minimum of 60 credits per academic year*

## **Language Arts: (40 Credits)**

2 Sem: English I  
2 Sem: English II  
2 Sem: English III or AP Lang  
2 Sem: Eng IV OR AP Lit

## **Social Studies (70 Credits)**

2 Sem: Geography or AP Human Geog  
2 Sem: World History or AP World History  
2 Sem: US History or AP US History  
1 Sem: Civics  
1 Sem: Economics or Cross-Cultures  
2 Sem: Passages  
2 Sem: Connections/Portfolio  
2 Sem: Electives

## **Mathematics (40 Credits)**

2 Sem: Integrated Math 1 (Algebra 1)  
2 Sem: Integrated Math 2 (Geometry)  
2 Sem: Advance Algebra 2  
2 Sem: Higher level math

## **Science (30 Credits)**

2 Sem: Biology  
2 Sem: Chemistry

## **World Language**
